As a young resident in Thornbury, we hope you will be able to help his Lordship by completing the various activities. They are for children between the **ages of 6-12**. You don't have to complete all of them – just pick and choose between the options.

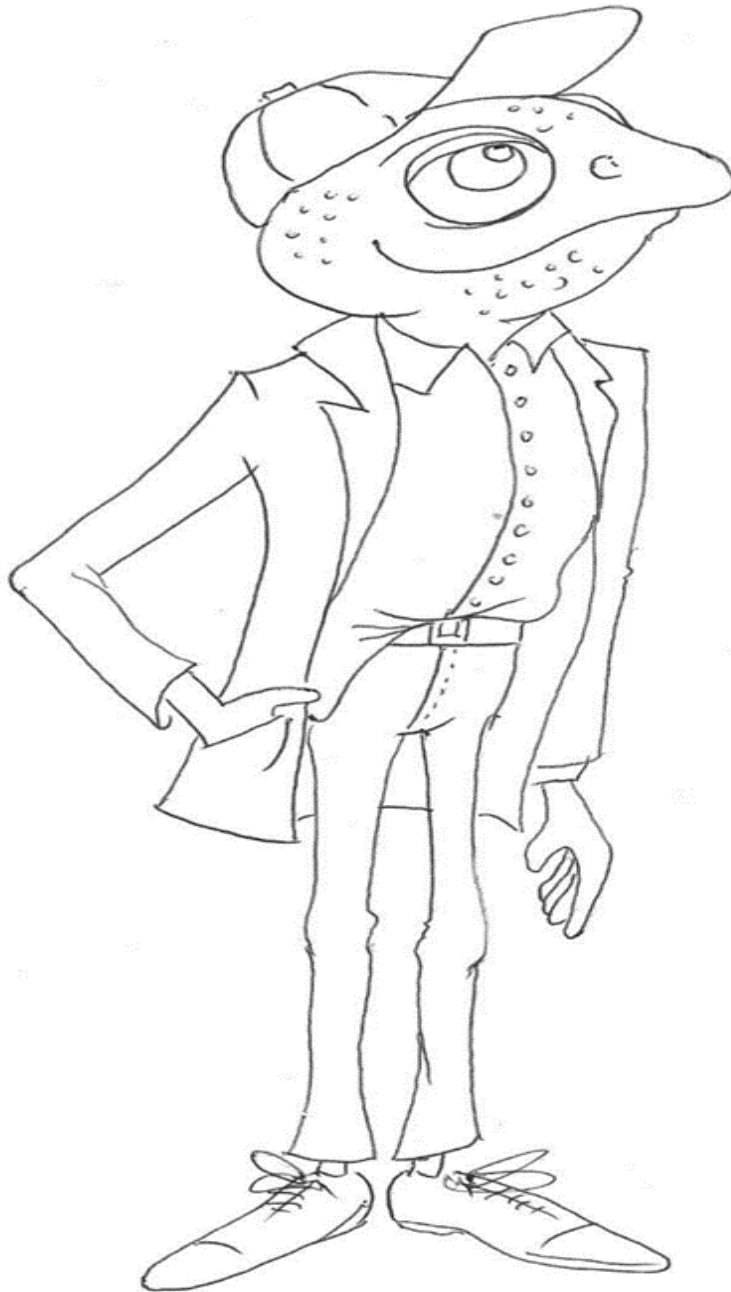

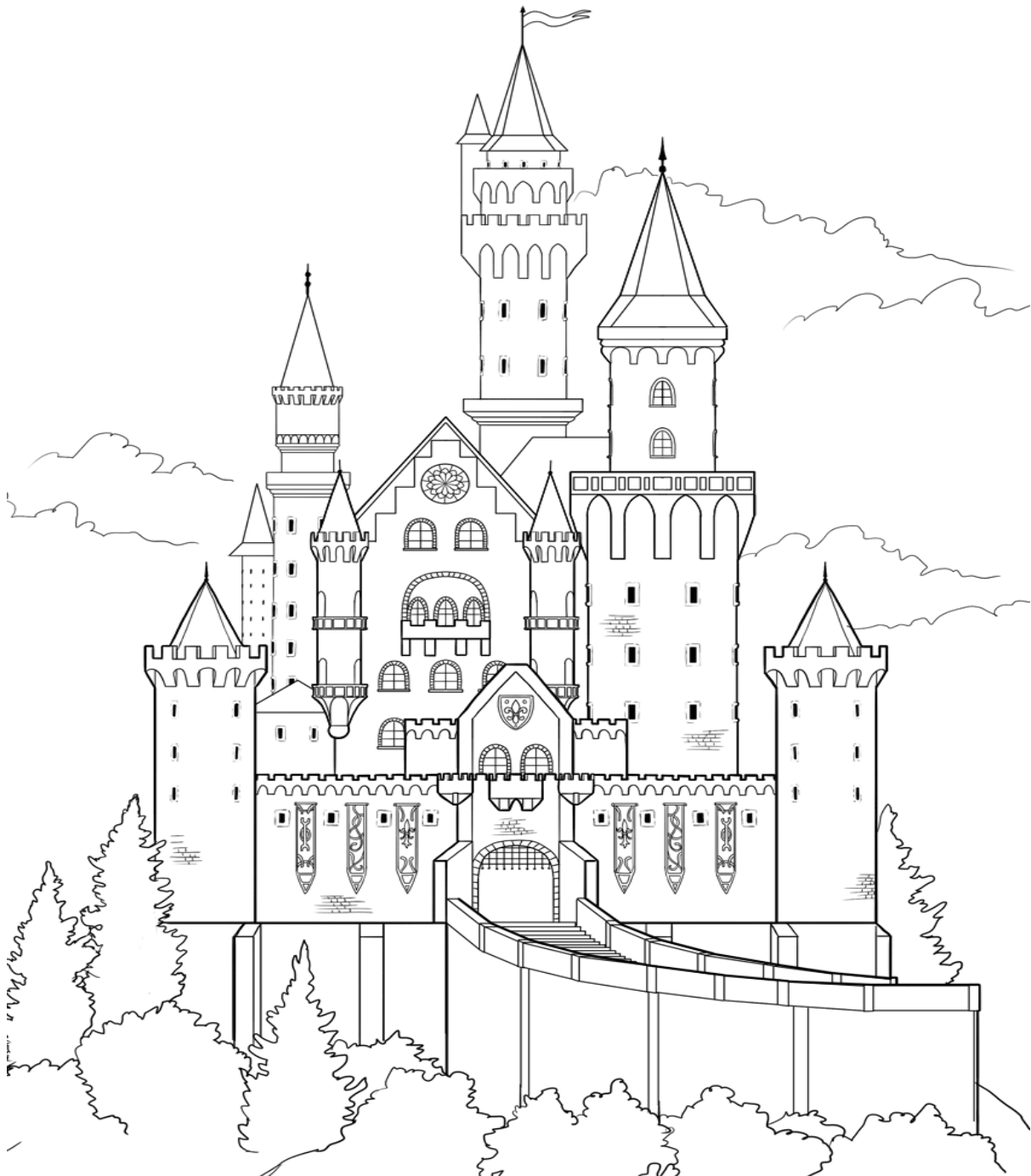

Activity Three

We now need you to help find a property for Lord Toadbury. There are a lot of Estate Agents in Thornbury and if you look in their windows you will see photos of homes with details and the asking price. Lord Toadbury would like you to:

- [] draw a picture of the home you suggest he should live in. This can be hand-drawn or computer generated
- [] say where it is located [remember he wants to live as close to the town centre as possible] and why this is the ideal place
- [] explain what rooms are in the house – bedrooms, bathrooms, kitchen etc. You could even draw a plan of the inside of the house showing the layout – computer generated is fine if you prefer
- [] explain any features that exist which may be attractive to a toad who loves fishing and attending music festivals/carnivals
- [] state the price for the house

Activity Four

Lord Toadbury will consider a new-build – in other words, a house that is designed specifically for him. For such prestigious buildings, architects sometimes produce models and this is something his Lordship will be looking for. For this task, you need to make a model of a house that Lord Toadbury could live in – it just needs to be the outside, not the rooms inside.

You could use a box such a shoebox, large delivery box etc or building bricks such as Lego. Because his Lordship shares our views of protecting the environment, perhaps you could include as much recycling as possible when creating your design.

Activity Five



Lord Toadbury loves the garden and feels it is just as important as the dwelling. He will be looking for someone to carry out a landscaping project and so would like you to submit your ideas by producing a garden on a dinner plate or in a cake tin.

He likes flower borders and will need a small pond so these must feature as part of the design.

This activity will be judged by Jolies Fleurs and we may need to take a photo in case any of the flora or fauna forming part of the design, passes its best. This entry has to be submitted directly to Jolies and you need to submit:

The prize for this activity is gardening equipment so you can have a go at making your own garden at home, or helping grown-ups.

Activity Six

This is a great activity for budding artists:

Lord Toadbury will require some artwork to hang in his gallery. He will be bringing pictures of his ancestors but wants some original art produced by local residents.

On a sheet of A4 create a piece of artwork you think his Lordship would like – it must be hand-drawn, not computer generated. You can use whatever medium you like – water colours, poster paints, pencil, crayons or felt pens. The theme is **'Life in Thornbury'**. Think of the things that happen in the town eg the Carnival, Thornbury in Bloom, Switching on of the Lights, historic sites such as the Castle, the local clubs and activities etc etc.

This activity will be judged by Richard and Emma of Surroundings in St Mary Street, Thornbury and so please hand in your entries at this shop.

Activity Seven



This activity is for those who like cake decorating. His Lordship is nearly 100 years old and requires a very special cake for his birthday. Dee of Dee's Cakes will be commissioned to make it but she is very busy and wants you to create the design.

It is going to be a one-tier 20cm round cake and will be iced in fondant which is sometimes called ready to roll icing. You need to produce a sketch of the cake highlighting the colours and details. This has to be very clear as Dee is going to judge and produce the winning entry*.

This entry has to be submitted to Finishing Touches where Dee's Cakes and Cake School are based. * If the winning entry needs a cake to be made to a specific dietary requirement, that is no problem.

Activity Eight

This is a **special entry and is for ages 5-18** – it can be produced as a **group** and is for those of you who love the performing arts. You need to produce a short video [no more than five minutes] which introduces Thornbury to Lord Toadbury. Being an elderly gentleman he finds it difficult to walk very far and he hasn't got used to his mobility scooter yet. The video can take the form of:

- a rap/dance
- a guided tour with a difference
- a news report
- a holiday programme

The choice is yours and the criteria is deliberately vague so that you can use your imagination.

The video will be judged by Management Staff at St Mary Centre.

The first prize for this activity is £100 and the video will be posted on the St Mary Centre, Cake School and Finishing Touches websites.

The runners up will receive £50.
